MOUTHGUARD INSTRUCTIONS



- 1. Drop mouthguard into boiling water for 7 seconds. Remove with tongs.
- 2. Place mouthguard IMMEDIATELY around upper teeth. Mouthguard will be warm but will not burn. INSTANTLY secure guard by pressing tongue against back of upper teeth. While holding the guard in this position, SUCK OUT all air and water until guard molds to a tight fit around upper teeth.
- 3. Remove mouthguard and place in cold water. If you do not get a tight fit, repeat procedure. Use marking pencil for identification. For smaller mouths, guards may be shortened by cutting along rib marks just above the arrows as indicated.
